RE: Office Closure and Programming Update

Dear Write Around Portland Community,

Based on recent developments in the evolving coronavirus situation, including [Governor Kate Brown's recommendations around social distancing](#), **Write Around Portland will be suspending all in-person programming, workshops, meetings, volunteer shifts, and events starting March 12 through at least April 17.**

Because of our mission and values, and our commitment to build respect, writing, and community—especially in a time when people may experience even more isolation—we are exploring ways we can continue offering our programming remotely, including sending postcards and letters, holding online workshops when possible, and increasing our communication on social media and through email with invitations and inspirations to continue writing and connecting.

We are working with our spring network workshop partner agencies to close the current season and offer opportunities for participants to be included in our book and reading in fall 2020.

Write Around Portland staff will be working remotely and will be available by [email](#) Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm. We encourage people to contact us by email during this time.

Staff will also be checking voice messages once per day, Monday-Friday, through our main office number 503-796-9224. We are not accepting office visits at this time.

**Currently, our intention is to return to the office after April 17.** We will notify you of any changes or additional updates as soon as possible.
